General Information:

1. The technical works (papers) should imply significant contributions to the event in one or more of the suggested topic areas.
2. IEEE policy regarding plagiarism will be strictly enforced. Technical works (papers) with information reproduced without a correct permission will be returned without revision.
3. The selection of the technical works will be done by the Technical Program Evaluation Committee (see list) designated by the Technical Program Committee of CONCAPAN XXIX. The number of technical works selected for oral presentation in technical sessions during CONCAPAN XXIX is conditioned to the number of sessions selected to have per area (schedule limitations).
4. The Technical Program Committee of CONCAPAN XXIX will make the final decision upon the works to be presented in technical sessions and will notify to the authors about their selection. It will also prepare the final version of the technical program.
5. The proceedings of the CONCAPAN XXIX will be provided to all attendees in a CD-ROM format. It will contain all the works to be presented in the technical sessions, as well as the presentation (slides) in MS-PowerPoint.
6. The supporting devices for the oral presentation of the technical works will be: a projector, a screen, computer, audio, etc. Any other kind of audiovisual equipment or software should be requested in advance to the Technical Committee.
7. The oral presentations are limited to 40 minutes with an additional 5 or 10 minutes for questions.
8. All authors (lecturers) must register to the CONCAPAN XXIX with a paid registration (see fees). Being part of this event will give you the following privileges: access to all the technical conference program, daily lunch, refreshments during intermissions, conference certificate as author, proceedings of the event (in CD-ROM), participation on conference social events.
9. The registration of more than one technical work per author is not permitted.
10. Author(s) must send a resume or CV with their technical work (paper).
